Fund helps to kit out emergency Responder for Caterham

Tandridge Community Fund made their biggest donation to date when Chairman Mike Moss MBE presented a cheque for £1,000 to Dawn Lewin, Team Leader of the Caterham District Community First Responders on Thursday 9th May.

The First Responders are all local volunteers who help the public by attending 999 medical emergency calls in their locality. Because they live locally they can often get to a medical emergency before the paramedics, especially if the ambulance has been delayed by traffic or other circumstances.

Until recently Caterham had just one part-time volunteer Responder, Dawn Lewin but she has now been joined by Jill Greaves who can provide further hours of voluntary cover for the Caterham area.

On presenting the cheque Mike Moss said: "I am very pleased to present this £1,000 to the Responders who I think are vital to the community. This is the largest aid that Tandridge Community Fund has been able to make since its formation in October 2008, and it is due to the fact that the Fund has now reached some £130,000 in capital so we should be

able to help more local groups." Dawn replied: "Caterham District Community Responders was set up in 2009 and we need more volunteers and equipment to do this vital work. We are very grateful to the Tandridge Community Fund, with the help of the Community Foundation for Surrey, for this very generous donation of £1,000 which will enable us to purchase another defibrillator (AED) and medical kit. This will mean that our second Community First Responder, Jill Greaves, will be fully equipped to help with our life saving emergency response work in the Caterham area."

Diary of a plantaholic

With the worst weather for 51 years, and very cold nights even at the beginning of June, planting and preparing for my 'Garden Open Days' has been extremely difficult. Many plants have just been so slow to get going. Others have gone mouldy. Even the tomatoes in the greenhouse were too cold to make any new growth. Then came the sun for a few days and the difficult start seemed an age ago.

The Alliums (purple sensaand the smaller christophii, both planted in the autumn) are not usually out at the same time. The Dutch iris, dark blue and yellow were gorgeous. They were put in pots so that as they finished new plants (Eucomis - the 'pineapple' plant) were put in their place. I have done the same thing with gladioli and earlier, the tulips. They get several feeds of tomato fertiliser and a small amount of 'Miracle Gro' so that as they die down, they take the food down with



them, and build up the bulb for next year.

Although the garden is now very full, the good news is that there is not much room for weeds! The same cannot be said for slugs though. They love snuggling under the pots and undergrowth.

So far the sawfly caterpillar which decimates the beautiful Solomons Seal and other plants, hasn't shown up yet. A precautionary spray with 'Provado ultimate bug killer' could be used. It is also good to get rid of lily beetle, if you find the idea of squashing them repugnant.

The Hydrangeas have got the very smallest of flower buds. so I shall start putting the 'blueing powder' on regularly from now on, as I much prefer them blue







Eating

An authentic Indian dining experience in South Croydon

Review by Julia Church

Anyone who remembers the Comedy Club in South Croydon may be fascinated to know that the building has been converted into a spacious Indian restaurant!

The building originally opened as a cinema in the early 1900's, then became Scots Dine and Dance in the 70's before becoming the Comedy Club.

When I dined at 'Fushia' recently with my sister Helen we could imagine cinemagoers purchasing their tickets in the entrance foyer before either going downstairs to the stalls (now the restaurant) or upstairs to the circle, which is now a large banqueting suite. There were already a number of Indian diners in the restaurant and Srini the owner told me that 70% of his customers are Indian as the food they serve is authentic Indian cuisine. They like to prepare regional favourites depending on which part of India the

customer is from to remind them of home, which we thought was a wonderful touch! Helen and I were served a range of dishes recommended by Srini starting with 'Garlic Chilli Mogo', South African cassava fried in garlic chilli sauce. It made a superb starter as neither Helen or I had eaten cassava before and it was lovely and crunchy with just the right amount of spiciness.

Srini then brought up a Mixed Grill for us to share consisting of sheekh kebab, lamb chops, chicken wings, king prawns and tandoori chicken served on a sizzler which, Helen commented, looked amazing. It was all beautifully cooked and Srini explained that all the dishes are freshly prepared, not heated up in a microwave, which means that serving can take a little while. Customers in a hurry can choose from a separate 'Express' part of the menu which features those dishes that are quicker to prepare and cook. Srini then served us two dishes from the 'Oriental Cuisine' section of the menu fish with vegetables and noodles and also meat with vegetables and noodles

I don't think either of us had eaten noodles in an Indian restaurant before - another first for us both! We did not need any accompanying vegetables or rice, we had all we needed on our plates and the curry flavour was wonderful. Although very full by now, Srini brought us yet another new thing for us to try, a dessert called 'Vatil Appal'. Made with coconut and other sweet ingredients, it melted in our mouths and was the perfect end to the meal. Srini said that it is hugely popular with Indian customers who cannot buy it in the UK or prepare it them-

The clocktower in **Oueen's Park**

The plague at the base of the clock tower in Queen's Park, Caterham states: 'Presented to the people of Caterham by Mrs E M Wilson 5th May 1954'.

Mrs Edith Wilson, a former resident of Caterham and shop owner, had offered to donate £985 for the building of a clock tower as a memorial to her late husband. The final cost was £873. 2s. 11d.

When constructed the tower was approximately 16 feet with ornamental flower beds at the base. The clock, with its four dials, was visible from nearly the whole of the park and adjacent roads; but nowadays not so visible! Gillett & Johnston of Croydon provided the clock mechanism. The firm was established by William Gillett in 1844. The company gained a worldwide reputation by manufacturing turret clocks. In 1877 Arthur Johnston became a partner in the firm and expanded the business

to include a bell foundry which closed in the 1950s. Today the firm continues to produce large feature clocks, including turret, projecting and street clocks. They also restore church clocks and service church bells, and make weather vanes. Gillett & Johnston made the clock within the roundabout in Caterham Valley, commemorating the centenary of Rotary International in 2005.

Mrs Wilson died in 1992 at the age of 101 years; she bequeathed a sum of money for the building of a new clubhouse for the Caterham Bowling Club.
