Hillcroft celebrates launch of Darwin-themed garden

On Tuesday, 14th July a number of especially invited guests, including the great, great grandson of Charles Darwin, Randal Keynes, attended the official opening of Hillcroft Primary School's new Charles Darwin-inspired garden area. The famous scientist and author of 'The Origin of Species' lived not far from the school, at Down House in Kent, and used his own gardens as an extensive outdoor laboratory.

Hillcroft School in Chaldon Road, Caterham, hopes to inspire Darwin's wonder for natural history amongst its own staff and pupils with the new facility. The school has teamed up with The Hawthorns School in Bletchingley to secure over £4,000 in government funding to create the new facility for outdoor learning. The launch event was the culmination of a series of conservation days for parents and children of both schools.

The project was the brainchild of head of science at Hillcroft,

Tom Holloway. During his presentation to the guests at the launch event he said: "Although Darwin is famed for going to places like the Galapagos Islands, he did a lot of his experimentation and discovery in his own back garden. We want the children of Hillcroft to look upon this garden in a similar light, as a place of both enjoyment and education. You don't need a shiny fancy laboratory – just a sense of curiosity.

"Although it is science-themed, the garden will also have cross-curricular use as an outdoor teaching aid for help with literacy and numeracy."



Diary of a Plantaholic

by Sue Baines

A job in time saves 99 (well almost!). The bugs seem to be growing every bit as fast as the flowers at this time of year. The main culprits in my garden seem to be the ants. I always investigate if I see them walking up a stem, as ants always have a purpose. They take black fly and carefully place them on each stem, or leaf, knowing that within hours the black fly will have multiplied. The black fly are then milked by the ants, causing the plant to suffer dramatically. In hot weather the process seems to be exacerbated. I often look at a plant with dark stems and wonder why it is suddenly ailing. I have particularly noticed black fly, but greenfly and Lupin aphids (that are so cleverly disguised as part of the new flowers) will all be just as damaging. I try and squidge them when I see them, but if you do use a spray, make sure it is early morning, or late evening once the bees have finished.

Ants in the ground can also be quite destructive, as they 'sift the soil' drying out the plant roots. I have used ant nematodes, and this appeared to work in the soil. It does not kill them, but encourages them to move away from that area. Sadly it did not work in the conservatory, and I resorted to Antstop, which was more effective.

Cutting back, watering and feeding continues, as does tying up plants, hopefully before damage occurs. This year seems to have been particularly windy. Wet growth can be extremely heavy, so cut any surplus growth before a deluge, if possible.

Despite the challenges, the garden is still looking gorgeous.







My partner Roger and I visited on a Friday evening, looking forward to seeing how the familiar cafe venue worked as a steakhouse at night. We were recommended the Pinca la Colonia Malbec red wine from the 'small but well chosen' wine list, a lovely, smooth wine with a sweet and spicy aroma (£17.95)

I chose the Empanadas (Patties) for my starter and Roger chose the Ribs. My vegetarian pattes were made with Quorn mince, chopped olives, egg, raisins and spring onions and were very tasty. Roger said the special sauce on his Ribs had 'quite a spicy kick" and were nice and meaty. Nathaly said the sauce is called 'Chimmi Churri', made to their own special recipe.

I had a large portion of one of the starters for my main course, the lovely cheesy 'Aubergine Mendosa' but there was also the option of the 'Crespolini' (homemade crepes) on the main course choices, which I look forward to trying another time. There were also chicken and seabass/salmon options on the menu for those not wanting
