Concil considers ambitious plans for town regeneration

On Thursday 15th March, Tandridge District Council's Planning Policy Committee met to consider the Caterham Masterplan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). This document will establish the quidelines to help shape and deliver an ambitious regeneration plan for Caterham town centre and Caterham-on-the-Hill over the next ten years and will build on the work prepared in the Caterham Town Design Statement. The Council will also consider the results of the Draft Caterham Masterplan Consultation, which ran for eight weeks and finished on Monday 22nd January.

During the consultation the proposals were viewed by 2,466 people on the Caterham Masterplan website and around 200 people attended one of three exhibition events. Key proposals include:

- Redevelopment of the former Rose & Young site.
- Redevelopment of Church Walk Shopping Centre to provide better, larger shops and a cinema.
- · The creation of a more attractive, pedestrian friendly

area in Caterham Valley, to include new high specification homes and flexible office space.

- · Improvement of Town End and revitalising vacant shops.
- Regeneration of Raglan Precinct.

The comments received during the consultation were taken into account and as a result changes have been made to the final Caterham Masterplan SPD. Overall the plan was supported, in particular the redevelopment of Church Walk and Raglan Precinct. The changes made include:

- Responding to the concerns about the proposal to reduce the width of the road on Station Avenue and other key routes. Further transport modelling will now be undertaken before any changes to the road layout and the focus will be on prioritising traffic calming and flows alongside public realm improvements.
- The need for improved and additional car parking, particularly in the Waitrose, Quadrant House and Church Walk areas.
- Removal of the community use proposal for Town End car
- A comprehensive delivery schedule to show key actions and ensure timely delivery.
- Considering the programme in line with the Local

Plan Infrastructure Delivery Plan, which will take into account the impact of ongoing development within the district and identify what infrastructure is required, how much it will cost, how it could be funded and when it could be delivered.

Development of this size and nature takes some time to be delivered, but the Caterham Masterplan will ensure the right things are brought forward for the town in an appropriate manner. The Council and its consultants continue to work with landowners to progress delivery.

The owners of Church Walk are aiming to submit a planning application in summer 2018. The owner of the former Rose & Young site in Caterham and Clarion Housing Group (CHG) have exchanged contracts for the sale of the site. CHG has planning permission for 48 dwellings, with a supermarket on the ground floor and the Council said they are continuing to monitor the progress of this project



Diary of a Plantaholic

by Sue Baines

After the "Beast from the East", spring was momentarily put on hold. There are plenty of scorched leaves which will take a while to grow out. I had tied up the Cordylines with raffia just to protect the crowns, and for the first time used scaffold pole foam wrap (used on building sites) for the trunks. They look to have come through unscathed.

The same can't be said for the Penstemons, which look miserable even though they weren't cut back. I did take a lot of Penstemon cuttings, but they may take another year to reach maturity.

Luckily, although I had cut back the Roses and Clematis, I hadn't even started the Hydrangeas and the old heads gave protection. I am going to make a start on thinning out the oldest stems and any that look unproductive. The best stems will be cut back to the first two healthy buds from the top, or lower, where space is limited. They will be given a long-life feed for ericaceous plants, as mine are in pots of ericaceous soil. This means with a bit of bluing pow-

der (easily available from any garden centre), they have lovely blue flowers. I don't use rain water, but that would be ideal. If they are planted in the garden, it will depend whether soil is acid or alkaline (chalky). In chalk they remain pink. There are so many varieties now and some are much darker than others. White Hydrangeas remain white.

Plenty of self sown seedlings are appearing. They are hardy annuals that tolerate the cold. Now is a great time to sow them but the half hardies need to be cosseted until the risk of frost is over.

I really miss seed sowing, but I need to evaluate every plant and remove the "thugs" and those not earning their keep, which sounds so easy. I'm sure there will still be too many ... I hope so!!

Eating Out

Enjoy great Indian and Chinese food at The Crown and Pepper

Review by Julia Church

The Crown and Pepper cocktail bar/gastro lounge in Caterham Valley has two Indian chefs and two Chinese chefs serving freshly-cooked, authentic Indian and Chinese cuisine every day. There is also a selection of "Indo-Chinese" appetisers, which my friend Anne opted for on our recent visit. Neither of us had tried Indo-Chinese food before, so we were sharing a new experience. I ordered Kung Pao Potatoes, and Anne ordered Chicken Manchurian. My Kung Pao Potatoes were like chunky chips with a wonderful spicy glaze and Anne's Chicken Manchurian was mouth-watering, bite-size pieces of chicken in batter with a chilli, ginger and garlic sauce. Both portions were very generous and perfect for sharing.

For our main courses, I chose a vegetarian dish from the Chinese selection - Bean curd in Ginger Garlic Sauce and Anne also chose a Chinese dish - the



Singapore rice noodles. We ordered a Mixed Vegetable Fried Rice to share. Chirag, the restaurant owner, recommended we also share one of the vegetarian Indo-Chinese appetisers as a side dish - the Chow Chow Cauliflower with soy sauce dip.

The food was perfectly cooked and represented great value for money. After our generous starters, we could not eat all of our main course, but the restaurant was ready to box-up our left-overs for us to take home! My Bean Curd dish was very mild, complemented well by the spicier cauliflower accompaniment, and Anne said she loved her fine Singapore noodles which were very delicate. She commented on what a great vibe the restaurant had, saying it was the "London buzz" in Caterham. We finished our meal with an


