April 1st sees launch of the Caterham Pothole Club

On Sunday 1st April, an exciting new piece of "hub cap art" appeared near the top of Church Hill in Caterham, on the railings at the junction with Stanstead Road. The hub caps spelled out the words: "Caterham Pothole Club" and were the latest April Fools Day joke for the local community by Andy Parr MBE and his friends. The display, consisting of 125 hubcaps painstakingly tied onto the railings the night before by Andy & Co, had a serious message directed at Surrey Highways, to draw attention to the many potholes that have formed along Church Road over recent months.

Andy said: "I started to collect the hub caps on my walks round to the King and Queen pub in the High Street. So many had been damaged and fallen off cars thanks to accidentally driving through potholes. I think Church Road is particularly bad, possibly the worst road in the area, and I don't know why. It was fully resurfaced about five years ago, around the same time as the High Street and Church Hill, which have both survived a lot

Speaking in March about the investment Surrey County Council (SCC) is spending on its roads, Cabinet Member for Highways, Colin Kemp, said: "We know our road network is under-funded by central government and we are not able to maintain our roads at the levels our residents expect. SCC cabinet has taken the decision to invest an additional £5 million in these roads to help reverse the impact of the winter's weather. This will deliver 33 larger schemes, 300 smaller schemes and 22 miles of surface dressing to seal the repaired roads. This work will be done on our very busy B and C roads that our residents use to get to and from work.

"We will talk to local members

and local highways teams to build a picture of where this work is needed. Our commitment is to start to deliver the smaller schemes during next month and the larger schemes in June/July this year. In the meantime we will continue to respond to any defects that are reported on our network."



Geocachers explore the country looking for objects hidden by others, and which are found by using GPS technology.


The focus of this event was

Diary of a **Plantaholic**

Suddenly there is everything to do, even though I am not opening the garden this year. The light levels are soaring and after months of trying to find enough light, I am having, on sunny days, to give shade and ventilation to lots of the over-wintered plants. Before hardening them off outside, I have given the tender cuttings and conservatory plants a dose of Nematodes (for vine weevil). It's so easy to move a couple of infected plants around the garden, ignorantly spreading the problem. Geoff has taken out the misshapen espalier apple trees that formed a barrier to stop our young nieces and nephews climbing on the wall. They have never been productive and have been replaced by rope, as similar as possible to rope on the other side.

Various Clematis collected over the last year with well-established roots have been planted in soil from our compost bins. I have used Rootgrow as there is

Clematis really thrive on deep, rich, moisture-retentive soil. Hopefully this will help the roots to establish in less than ideal conditions. If they don't look happy at the end of the summer I will just have to take the soil out at that end.

I have started to feed lots more, now that the plants are really growing, in the hope that as they start to grow, the winter "burnt" leaves will be shed for fresh new growth. If the plants still appear dead I will lightly scrape the bark to see if there is any sign of life before replacing them.

After quite a cold spring I will be keeping the fleece handy in case there is a sudden cold snap, although hopefully, summer is just around the corner.




